2025 AIA COLORADO IMPACT AWARD

September 19, 2025 — Denver, CO Established to recognize Colorado architects and firms who are reinforcing the value of design and celebrating the many ways the profession contributes to positive change, the 2025 AIA Colorado Design + Honor Awards were presented at an award ceremony last night at Denver's Tivoli Turnhalle, with *Modern In Denver* magazine receiving the 2025 Impact Award.

The Impact Award recognizes a group or organization in Colorado that has made a positive impact on Colorado communities and significantly contributes to the advancement of architecture and/or enhanced the role of practitioners. *Modern In Denver* was awarded in honor of the publication's broad impact on the

architectural community through 17 years of publishing elevated design discourse in the Rocky Mountains.

“I cannot think of anyone more deserving for the recognition of this year’s AIA Impact Award than *Modern In Denver* and its founder, William Logan,” says Brad Tomecek, FAIA, founding principal of Tomecek Studio Architecture. “The *Modern In Denver* team embraces diverse, curated topics relating to culture, planning, and landscape, alongside architecture. They are deeply committed to their mission to educate people on how good design makes a difference, as well as to the community, reminding us that coming together to celebrate our passions and connect is important above all else.”

Founded by William Logan in 2008, *Modern In Denver* publishes a quarterly print magazine that includes features on residential and commercial design projects, contemporary artist and architect profiles, Travel by Design specials, product roundups, exhibition and book reviews, and critical conversations on design innovations, urban planning, and building science. In addition to the award-winning print publication, for six years *Modern In Denver* created and produced Denver Design Week, an annual seven-day showcase of the region’s best architecture, interiors, art, brands, and technology.

“Design journalism should inform, educate, and inspire, and that’s what we’ve worked hard over the course of nearly two decades to deliver to the community,” William Logan says. “It’s been a great privilege to be able to publish coverage of so many designers, thinkers, artists, and makers who share our belief that great design not only makes our world more beautiful, but also drives change, shapes culture, and redefines what’s possible.
